Dear Brothers,

As many of you know, I started as House Director for the Indiana Chapter (Bloomington, IN) in June 1997 and worked there for the next four years. On August 1, 2001, I started as the Assistant Executive Director for Acacia International Headquarters, working alongside Darold

Larson, our long time Executive Director. On October 1, 2011, I took over the reigns as Executive Director. When my Acacia career began those 16 years ago, little did I know that I would find myself as the Executive Director of our beloved Fraternity.

The last 12 years have been extremely rewarding. My appreciation and love for Acacia has only grown during this time. I have met friends and brothers that would not have been afforded to me in the past, traveled across the country, and worked with some of the greatest men in the world. For these, I am most grateful.
